



Beach Volleyball

Date of competition: 6-7th August, 2025.

1. VENUE

Beach volleyball courts (2) at Tallinn Freedom Square

2. TECHNICAL COMMITTEE

The Technical Committee will be comprised of:

- Technical Director
- Assistant Technical Director
- Head Referee
- Member of ICG TC

3. IDENTIFICATION

All athletes must show their accreditation card to the referee before competing. Without the card, the athlete will not be allowed to compete.

NO EXCEPTIONS.

4. COMPETITION INFORMATION

- A team consists of two players
- Number of teams that can participate: 12 boys' teams and 12 girls' teams
- One coach per squad.
- Field size is 16 by 8 meters
- Net height for both boys and girls will be 224 cm

5. COMPETITION RULES:

- The regulations of the International Volleyball Federation (FIVB) are leading in the competition.
- The match is played in two sets won by 21 points, with a possible third set up to 15 points.
- Sets must be won by two points difference
- The official FIVB ball Mikasa VLS300 shall be used in all categories



- Time-outs: each team is allowed 1 time-out per set, lasting 30 seconds.
- A ball is “in” when the imprint of the ball is visible on the line
- A team may have three contacts with the ball: after the third contact, the ball must be played to the opponent
- Change sides after each 7 points played, after 5 points played in the case of a 3rd set.

6. DISPUTES

- Any dispute will be resolved in compliance with FIBA rules and the clauses included in the ICG sports rules.
- Any official protest will be referred to the Protest Committee according to the ICG rules..

7. DISCIPLINARY RULES

- The ICG Code of Conduct must be adhered to at all times.
- Heads of Delegation, athletes and coaches will be excluded from the Games for indecent behaviour, offence made through words and/ or actions, violent behaviour, abusive language etc.
- All Delegations have to comply with any instruction made by the venue staff.
- Coaches are responsible for the well-being and behaviour of their athletes at all times.

8. PRESENTATION OF MEDALS

The following medals will be awarded immediately after the tournament:

GOLD – for team ranking first in the competition

SILVER – for team ranking second in the competition

BRONZE – for team ranking third in the competition

- Athletes must wear their team uniform or tracksuit for the ceremony.
- No flags of any type, city or country, will be allowed to be on display at the Medal Ceremony.
- No medals will be awarded to coaches.
- Medal presentations will be made at the designated time as per the schedule.
- Coaches are requested to assist in ensuring athletes are readily available and correctly dressed for the medal presentation.

9. TRAINING SCHEDULE

Training times will be available at the venue on 4th August 2025.

Training schedule will be posted on the website.

10. MEDICAL

A First Aid Service will be available on site.

Full Medical Service will be available at one of the hospitals in Tallinn.

11. TECHNICAL MEETING

A technical meeting for all coaches will be held on 4th August 2025.
Time and venue will be provided upon arrival.
