

Fencing

Date of competition: 4-6th August, 2025.

1. VENUE

Tallinn Athletics Hall

2. TECHNICAL COMMITTEE

The Technical Committee will be comprised of:

- Head Referee
- Assistant Technical Director
- · Member of ICG TC

3. IDENTIFICATION

All athletes must show their accreditation card to the referee before competing. Without the card, the athlete will not be allowed to compete.

NO EXCEPTIONS.

4. COMPETITION RULES:

- Competitions are for BOTH individual and team.
- Type of weapon is an epee.
- Competitions are held according to the rules of the International Fencing Federation (FIE), for boys and girls.
- Team composition: 4 boys, 4 girls, 1 coach.
- All competitors must be at the venue 45 minutes before the designated time of the fight.

5. DISPUTES

- Any disputes will be resolved in accordance with FIE rules and the clauses included in the ICG Rules.
- Any protests will be referred to the Protest Committee according to the ICG Rules.

6. DISCIPLINARY RULES

The ICG Code of Conduct must be adhered to at all times.



- Heads of Delegation, athletes and coaches will be excluded from the Games for indecent behaviour, offence made through words and/ or actions, violent behaviour, abusive language etc.
- · All Delegations have to comply with any instruction made by the venue staff.
- Coaches are responsible for the well-being and behaviour of their athletes at all times.

7. PRESENTATION OF MEDALS

The following medals will be awarded immediately after the tournament:

GOLD – for athlete and team ranking first in the competition

SILVER – for athlete team ranking second in the competition

BRONZE – for athlete and team ranking third in the competition

- Athletes must wear their team uniform or tracksuit for the ceremony.
- No flags of any type, city or country, will be allowed to be on display at the Medal Ceremony.
- No medals will be awarded to coaches.
- Medal presentations will be made at the designated time as per the schedule.
- Coaches are requested to assist in ensuring athletes are readily available and correctly dressed for the medal presentation.

8. TRAINING SCHEDULE

Training times will be available at the venue on 4th August 2025. Training schedule will be posted on the website.

9. MEDICAL

A First Aid Service will be available on site.

Full Medical Service will be available at one of the hospitals in Tallinn.

10. TECHNICAL MEETING

A technical meeting for all coaches will be held on 4th August 2025. Time and venue will be provided upon arrival.
