- WHEREAS, both Annapolis, the capital of Maryland and Tallinn, the capital of Estonia have long traditions of seafaring and are centers of history, culture and arts of their respective nations; and
- WHEREAS, both cities are abundantly blessed with beauty and fruitfulness of land and sea; and
- WHEREAS, the people of Annapolis and Tallinn believe that through programs of cooperation and exchange, their citizens will gain much in friendship and understanding of one another.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL that Tallinn, Estonia is hereby designated as a sister city for the City of Annapolis.
